

## Test Specification on the subject «The English Language»

### 1. The aim of the test

Evaluation of knowledge and skills in the subject "The English language" during the contest for the vacant position of a "teacher of English" in the branches of the autonomous educational organization "Nazarbayev Intellectual Schools" (hereinafter - AEO).

### 2. Normative documents that are the basis for testing

The rules of the competition for vacant positions and the formation of teachers' personnel reserve in the branches of the autonomous educational organization "Nazarbayev Intellectual Schools" engaged in educational activities, approved by the decision of the Board of AEO (No. 37 dated August 08, 2023).

### 3. Documents determining the content of the test:

1. State obligatory standard of general secondary education.
2. State obligatory standard of basic secondary education.
2. State obligatory standard of higher education.
4. Model curriculum for the subject "English" for grades 7-9 of the level of basic secondary education according to the updated curriculum.
5. Model curriculum for the subject "English" for grades 10-11 of the level of general secondary education in the natural and mathematical direction according to the updated curriculum.
6. Standard curriculum on the subject "English" for grades 10-11 of the level of general secondary education in the social and humanitarian direction according to the updated curriculum.

## 5. Structure, assessment, and duration of the test:

The test consists of 25 test items, with one correct answer out of five possible options. The test consists of three modules:

Module	Description
Module 1 (basic level)	Tasks of the basic level, corresponding to the standard curriculum in the subject "English" for general education.
Module 2 (advanced level)	Tasks aimed at testing the skills of linguistic, stylistic and literary text analysis of the artistic style of speech. Test items are aimed at testing high-level thinking skills.
Module 3 (high level)	Tasks aimed at testing the skills of analyzing the linguistic-stylistic and semantic-structural features of the text in a publicistic style. Test items are aimed at testing high-level thinking skills.

The time to complete the test is **80 minutes**.

The processing of test results is carried out by the Center for Pedagogical Measurements by automated statistical and psychometric analysis of the results of candidates, which reveals the level of complexity of each task and calculates their share in the final score for the test by equated scores. This approach provides objective and reliable assessment of the results, so there is no appeal.

The threshold level for passing the test is **60%** of the maximum score.
